ADDITIONAL GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS FOR ASSOCIATE OF ARTS DEGREE

- No developmental courses may be applied to this degree.
- Minimum Grade Point Average 2.0; only grades of "C" or better may be applied to this degree.
- Minimum 15 degree-applicable semester credits must be completed at FRCC.
- Submit graduation application, transfer credits, and credit for prior learning to Admissions & Records by deadline and complete CAAP exam (see Class Schedule for dates).
- The official graduation contract is based on the FRCC catalog in effect when the student formally matriculated into the program of study under which she/he plans to graduate.

Statewide Business Articulation Agreement

The Statewide Business Articulation Agreement ensures that a student who begins an Associate of Arts degree at a Colorado community college will transfer 60 credits into the Bachelor of Arts or Bachelor of Science in Business Administration degree program at a Colorado public four-year college (i.e., 60 + 60 agreement). The following four-year schools participate in this agreement:

- Adams State College
- Colorado State University
- Colorado State University – Pueblo
- Fort Lewis College
- Mesa State College
- Metropolitan State College of Denver
- University of Colorado at Boulder
- University of Colorado at Colorado Springs
- University of Colorado at Denver
- University of Northern Colorado
- Western State College

This agreement does not guarantee admission to the School of Business. Transfer applicants to a business degree program are subject to the same admission requirements as native students applying for admission into a business program. It does guarantee, however, that admitted students who follow the conditions of this agreement will be guaranteed complete transfer of the A.A. degree and will enter with junior standing in the School of Business.

The four-year college or university will accept all eligible credits earned within ten years of transfer. Courses earned more than ten years earlier will be evaluated on an individual basis.

CLEP credits used to meet the requirements of this degree may not be accepted by the four-year college or university to which a student transfers.

AP scores must be 4 or higher to be applied to this degree.

Completion of the 40 credits of general education requirements that are included in this agreement may not satisfy all the general education requirements for every business program. Students should review the business degree requirements of the four-year college or university of their interest when making plans to transfer.

Students who have earned two-year degrees other than the A.A. with a Concentration in Business for Transfer or who have not fully completed the degree requirements will be evaluated on a course-by-course basis.
