

# A REGIS DIPLOMA IS WITHIN YOUR REACH

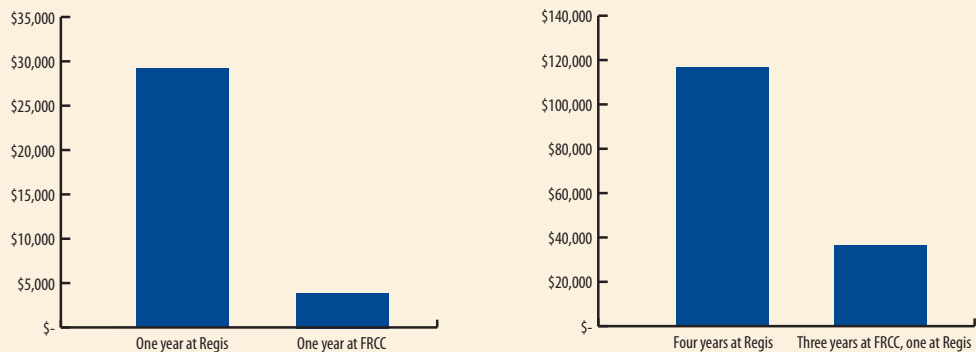
## Earn a Regis University bachelor's degree at 1/3 the Regis cost.
