**Spring 2016 FRCC STUDENTS
CO-ENROLLED AT OTHER INSTITUTIONS**

The Office of Institutional Research requests a report from the National Student Clearinghouse (NSC) every fall and spring semester to determine how many of our enrolled students are co-enrolled at another two- or four-year institution. While NSC data do not include all institutions, the information gives us a good picture of how many of our students are attending other schools at the same time they are attending FRCC.

FRCC has 988 students co-enrolled at other institutions this spring, 5.3% of our total spring student population. Following are the colleges with at least five FRCC students enrolled, including both 2-year and 4-year schools:
