**FALL 2013 FRCC STUDENTS  
CO-ENROLLED AT OTHER INSTITUTIONS  
NATIONAL STUDENT CLEARINGHOUSE**

The Office of Institutional Research requests a report from the National Student Clearinghouse (NSC) every fall and spring semester to determine how many of our students are co-enrolled at another two- or four-year institution. While NSC data do not include all enrolled students—only students who attend an institution that participates in the National Student Clearinghouse—the information gives us a good picture of how many of our students are attending other schools at the same time they are attending FRCC.

FRCC has 936 students co-enrolled at other institutions this spring, 4.7% of our total fall student population. This is similar to the percentage from prior years (Fall 2011 had 830, or 4.1%).

Following are the colleges with at least five FRCC students enrolled. In the past, our two institutions were CSU and CU Boulder with 50% of our co-enrolled students. This year, Aims has surpassed CU Boulder.

NSC provides the program students are studying in at their other college, based on majors and CIP codes. While not all schools report on the program, we have program information on 60% of our co-enrolled students. The most popular majors are Biological/Biomedical sciences and Business.
