HOW TO SCHEDULE A TUTOR

- 1. Students should fill out the study group tutoring request form *completely and accurately*. Without complete information, the tutoring office cannot place a tutor with a study group. This information includes an S number, Front Range student email address, a phone number, and the student's signature.
- **2.** Once students have completed a Study Group Request Form, one member of the group brings it to the office for scheduling.
- **3.** Scheduling will be followed by an email confirmation to the students' **FRCC email addresses**. All the students in the group have to confirm the time and day before the group can start.

INFORMATION FOR STUDENTS REQUESTING STUDY GROUP TUTORING

- Students who are enrolled in a credit class at the Boulder County Campus of FRCC can form a study group of 3-5 students for one hour of free weekly group tutoring. There is no grade requirement to join a study group.
- All tutoring takes place on the Boulder County campus. Students who wish to have additional study group session without a tutor have the option to meet off-campus, if they wish.
- Students are expected to attend every study group session. If the number of students who attend regularly drops below three, then the group will be disbanded.
- Tutors do not do homework for students. They are facilitators of student learning. Students should be prepared with goals and questions for each tutoring session.
- The 12th week of the fall or spring semester or the 8th week of the summer session is the last time students can form a study group with a tutor.
- Students must sign in at the computers by the main desk of the Student Success Center before every study group tutoring session.
