

Class Search Tips and Tricks in eWOLF

Location, Location, Location!

Remember to click Advanced Search to pick the campus location and additional search criteria.

FRCC has multiple campuses and locations so you need to be aware of where your classes are held. After searching, pay close attention to the location code.

Helpful Tips while searching for classes

- Click in the Subject box and hit a letter to skip to subjects that start with the letter (ie. click P to find subjects that start with this letter).
- Use the **CTRL** key to select multiple subjects, campuses or instructors.
- To find **All Classes** - Click on first subject and then hit the **Shift and End** key. Next choose the campus or campuses you want to attend.
- **Online Classes Only** - Use CTRL key to select FRCC CCCOnline and FRCC Online Campus for the campus.

After you pick Subject(s) and Campus(es) you can refine your search even more...

- **Late Start Classes** - Use CTRL key to select Part of Term choices that do not include "1st" or "15-week term" in the description.
- **GT Classes** - Under Attribute Type you can choose the guaranteed transfer discipline of choice. Use **Shift and End** to choose all.
- **Evening Classes** - Enter a Start Time such as 5 pm. This will show all classes starting at 5:00 pm or later.
- **Certain Days** - Pick a specific day or days. Note the broader you make your search the more results you will get. Always review days before you register for a class.

Additional Class Information

Once you are at the screen that shows the available classes click on the highlighted blue CRN to show the class notes and additional information such as prerequisites, co-requisites, etc.
