

What is TRIO Upward Bound?

The Front Range Community College TRIO Upward Bound (UB) Program serves as a supportive learning community to assist Westminster High School students and their families with navigating educational and career pathways. TRIO Upward Bound is sponsored by the U.S. Department of Education and will serve 60 students annually.

What are the benefits of participating in TRIO Upward Bound?

- Individualized coaching
- Academic preparation and college readiness
- Exposure to college and career pathways
- Expand financial decision-making skills
- Engage in fun enrichment activities
- Build social networks

Who can participate in Upward Bound?

Participants must meet all of the following:

- Attend Westminster High School
- Be a U.S. citizen or permanent resident
- Demonstrate academic need with potential for success

AND must meet at least one of the following:

- Be first-generation college bound (neither natural or adoptive parent(s)/guardian(s) earned a four-year college degree)
- Meet income eligibility requirements as determined by federal guidelines

APPLICATION PROCESS

TRIO Upward Bound will accept applications on an ongoing basis. Applicants may be placed on a waiting list until space is available.

<u>STEP 1 – Learn about Upward Bound and Program Commitments</u>

- Complete an interest form with your assigned counselor or Future Center staff.
 - Speak with Upward Bound staff via phone or in person during office hours.
 - Attend an information session during lunch or after school.

STEP 2 – Submit Application

If program is a good fit, submit *Participant Application* directly to Upward Bound or Future Center Staff during office hours.

<u>STEP 3 – Complete Interview and Recommendation Forms</u>

Applicants who meet minimum qualifications will be invited to an interview with Upward Bound staff and will be required to submit recommendation forms. Upward Bound staff will work with assigned counselor on completing the counselor recommendation form, and applicants will work directly with teachers to complete two teacher recommendation forms.

<u>STEP 4 – Be Selected as Participant and Commit to Program Services</u>

Applicants who are selected to participate are expected to regularly participate in program activities.

The following activities for 2017-2018 are listed below. Dates are tentative and subject to change.

- Regular Individual Coaching Sessions with UB Academic Counselor at Westminster High School
- UB Lab for homework completion and tutoring sessions at Westminster High School as needed
- Wolfpack Wednesday Sessions (1:00–5:00pm) group activities, cultural excursions, college visits
- Family Welcome and Orientation complete documentation for participation (May 9 or 12)
- Summer Session @ Front Range Community College, Westminster Campus (June 4 –July 13, 2018)
