Can I get a job as a manager?

- 8 percent increase in jobs nationally over the next eight years for first-line supervisors of office workers (U.S. Bureau of Labor Statistics)
- 898 job openings per year in Colorado for the next eight years for first-line supervisors of office workers (Department of Labor and Employment)

Salary	Entry	Average	Experienced
