The doi stands for digital object identifier. This identifies a location for an article stored online. Not all articles have a doi. If one is listed, include it in your citation.

Article from Online Databases with no doi listed.

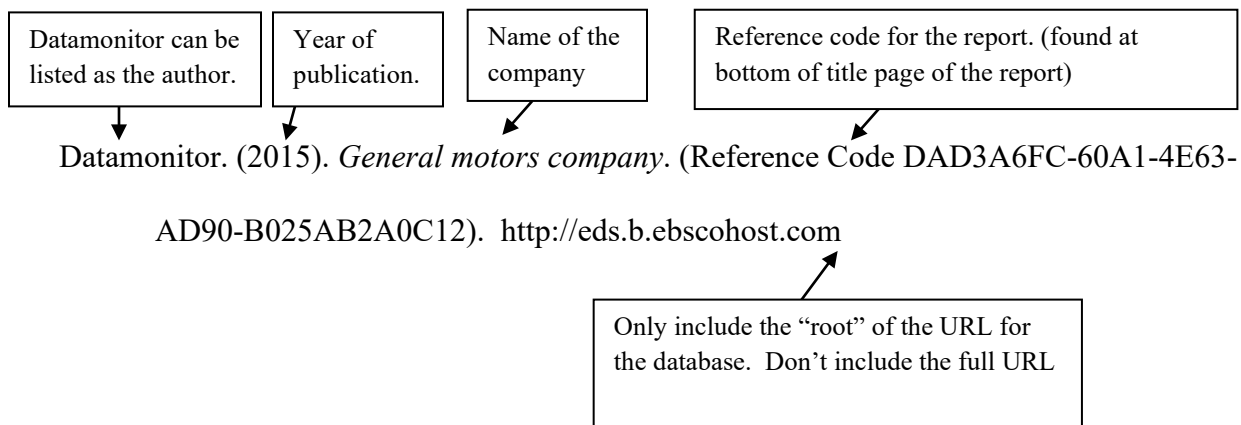
