Academic Search Premier

This database is an excellent catch-all source with 8000+ magazines, newspapers, and scholarly journals in Arts & Humanities to the Sciences.

CINAHL

The Cumulative Index to Nursing and Allied Health Literature is a gateway to many magazines and academic journals including nursing, biomedicine, alternative/complementary medicine, consumer health and 17 allied health disciplines.

Business Source Premier

From big topics like economics to day-to-day ones like employee relations and consumer psychology, BSP has academic journals and professional business magazines to cover any business-related topic.

Psychology and Behavioral Sciences

For research about how individuals (psychology) and groups (sociology) of people may act or think, this database contains academic journals and more popular sources.

History Reference Center

Designed for community colleges and undergraduate research, this database features full text for thousands of primary source documents, full-text content from 150 leading history journals, and encyclopedias.

Greenfile

This database has scholarly, government and general-interest sources covering the environmental effects of individuals, corporations and governments, covering disciplines such as agriculture, education, law, health and technology.

MasterFile Premier

MasterFILE Premier contains full text for magazines and publications that cover a wide-range of subject areas including business, health, education, general science and multicultural issues, as well as reference books and an extensive video and image collections.

Science Reference Center

This research database provides science-oriented content, with full text for hundreds of science encyclopedias, reference books, academic journals, magazines and other reliable sources.

JSTOR

Literally "Journal Storage," JSTOR is a classic and popular arts & humanities research database with 100+ years' worth of academic journals.

ERIC

The Educational Research Information Center was established by the US Department of Education in 1964, and is now a free government website that provides access to professional and scholarly materials about education, from Early Childhood through College.

Opposing Viewpoints in Context

Opposing Viewpoints is built around a series of Pro/Con essays written by experts on controversial topics, and then fleshed out by a mass of magazines, newspapers and other media sources.

CQ Researcher

CQ Researcher provides coverage of the most important issues of the day. Reports are written by experienced journalists and professionally fact-checked. Articles include an overview, historical background, chronology, pro/con feature, and resources for additional research.

Credo Contemporary Issues & Controversies

This database is a collection of reference encyclopedias on current issues, and provide well-balanced, thoroughly researched introductory articles that can provide nuanced insights.

CREDO & Gale Virtual Reference Library

Both of these are collections of digitized encyclopedias and dictionaries, which cover most topics and give readers instant access to thousands of articles that introduce complex topics.

Gale Artemis Literary Sources

As a premier literature research database, this includes primary sources, critical articles, literary and cultural analysis, and biographies that run back centuries.

Films on Demand

This database takes about 7,000 documentaries and films, and makes the searchable by 2-3 minute segments. It covers many disciplines but is strong in humanities and social sciences.

PubMedCentral

PMC is a free archive for full-text biomedical and life sciences journal articles and a repository for journal literature and manuscripts. The focus is on high-quality scientific literature.

Medline Plus

Produced by the National Library of Medicine, MedlinePlus provides information about diseases, conditions, and wellness geared towards patients and medical consumers.

Magill's Medical Guide

Magill's Medical Guide is both authoritative yet accessible reference source that helps bridge the gap between medical encyclopedias and dictionaries for professionals and popular self-help guides.

Physicians Desk Reference (PDR)

This online resource provides 2,300 drug guides by drug name, with drug guides on use and safety, written for the patient.

Mayo Clinic

The Mayo Clinic's Patient Care and Health Information site provides the public with an easy interface to research diseases, symptoms, tests, procedures, drugs, and supplements.

Salem Press (Primary Sources)
