

Instructions for completing the Selective Service Verification Form

- All male students born after December 31, 1959 are required to register with the Selective Service System.
- It is recommended that you prepare/compile the following information prior to starting the application process:
 1. Documentation to confirm date of birth (state/federal ID or birth certificate) if you were born before January 1, 1960
 2. DD-214 if you are a veteran on active duty in the U.S. Armed Forces (National Guard or Reserves are not included)
 - a. To obtain a copy, call the Veterans Administration at 1-800-827-1000
 3. Documentation of registration status if registered with Selective Service
 - a. To obtain verification of registration, log in to the Selective Service web page at www.sss.gov or call 1-847-688-6888)
 4. A copy of your date-stamped I-94 or port of entry papers if you entered the United States after your 26th birthday
 5. Documentation to confirm your gender (state/federal ID or birth certificate) if you are a female
 6. Copy of your Status Letter from Selective Service if you are not registered
 - a. Draft a personal statement to explain why you did not register
 7. If none of the above statements accurately describes your circumstance, please contact Selective Service at www.sss.gov or 1-847-688-6888 to request a Status Letter that acknowledges the reason for your non-registration status.
 8. Any additional supporting documentation to explain your circumstances
