Introduction

The Wheels Manufacturing Inc. Scholarship was established with the goal of supporting and incentivizing recent high school graduates pursuing a Machining Certificate and/or Degree at the Front Range Community College Boulder County campus. Wheels Manufacturing Inc. and the Front Range Community College Foundation (Foundation) have partnered to make this scholarship available to FRCC students.

Eligibility

Recipients of this scholarship will be selected based on the following established criteria:

1. Applicant must be enrolled full-time in the Machining Program for College Credit for the Fall semester of the 2017-2018 academic year.
2. Applicant must have at least a 2.5 GPA in High School.
3. Applicants are required to complete the FAFSA.
4. Applicant must be a Colorado resident.
5. Applicant must participate in the FRCC Foundation scholar success program.
6. Awardees must be willing to visit Wheels Manufacturing Inc.
7. Preference will be given to recent high school graduates.

Selection and Award Process

A scholarship selection process administered by the Foundation. The Foundation will review applications and make recommendations of the recipients for the scholarship awards to the executive director of the Foundation for final approval.

Procedure

Applicant must submit the following:

1. Scholarship Application (including application essay).
2. Two (2) letters of recommendation. This should emphasize the applicant's interest in manufacturing, detail ambitions, outline ambition etc.

Submission and Deadline

The deadline for this application is July 31st, 2017.
