


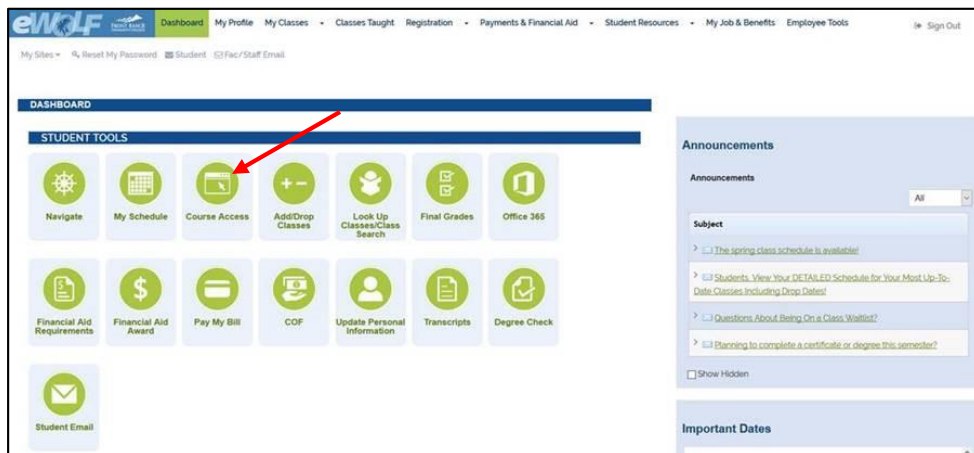
Logging into D2L

1. Go to www.frontrange.edu and access your eWOLF account in the top right corner of the page.
2. Enter your S number and password. If this is your first time logging in, your default password is your 6 digit date of birth. For example, if your birthday is October 23, 1989 enter 102389.





4. This will bring up a window with two links: The top link will take you to your D2L home page for all FRCC classes. If you are enrolled in a CCCOnline class, click the bottom link to go over to your CCCOnline D2L home page. CCCOnline classes have a section number that starts with a "c" (for example, ENG 121-c11 or MAT050-c21.) Any class that does not have a "c" in the section number is an FRCC class.

5. For all FRCC classes, your courses will appear in the right hand column of your D2L home page.
