## JOU 121 Course Information

**This FRCC college course develops photo-journalistic skills in capturing moments of real life from a unique personal viewpoint. Covers a broad overview of new media story-telling techniques. Students will focus on the way they observe the world around them and on the content and quality of their photographs.**

JOU 121 is not guaranteed to transfer to other public colleges and universities. However, it can be applied as an elective on the Associates of Arts and Science degrees at FRCC.

Photojournalism students must have regular access to a digital SLR camera with an 18-55 kit zoom lens. The camera should permit full manual control over aperture, shutter speeds, film speed settings (ISO or ASA), and focus. An automatic "point and shoot" camera will not meet the course requirements.

Students can expect to spend 6+ hours per week on this class at home, including reading, studying, writing papers, and completing other assignments. ## College Now Programs at Front Range Community College

Front Range Community College's College Now program allows students to earn both high school and college credit for the same FRCC class. In High School Select, students take FRCC classes that are conveniently offered at the high school.

All curriculum and expectations are the same as in a college class—the only difference is the location. Students should expect that High School Select classes will be more challenging with a heavier workload than most typical high school classes.

### What's the difference?

**College Now classes** are college classes that appear on the FRCC transcript. Many classes are transferable to other public schools in Colorado.

**AP classes** are high school classes that are designed to meet college competencies. Students must pay for and pass a test at the end of the year to determine if they qualify for college credit.

**College Now programs are tuition-free.**
