This FRCC college course covers performing safety inspections, making minor repairs, adjusting operating parameters, and operating SMAW equipment utilizing E-6010, E-6013, and E-7018 electrodes. Layout procedures and practices will also be introduced.

WEL 103 is not guaranteed to transfer to other public colleges and universities. However, it is a requirement for the Welding Technology Associates of Applied Science degree at FRCC, and it applies toward multiple FRCC welding certificates.

College Now Programs at Front Range Community College

Front Range Community College's College Now program allows students to earn both high school and college credit for the same FRCC class. In High School Select, students take FRCC classes that are conveniently offered at the high school.

All curriculum and expectations are the same as in a college class—the only difference is the location. Students should expect that High School Select classes will be more challenging with a heavier workload than most typical high school classes.

What's the difference?

College Now classes are college classes that appear on the FRCC transcript. Many classes are transferable to other public schools in Colorado.

AP classes are high school classes that are designed to meet college competencies. Students must pay for and pass a test at the end of the year to determine if they qualify for college credit.
