## GETTING STARTED IS AS EASY AS 1, 2, 3...

### 1 Apply for admission to Front Range Community College

- [www.frontrange.edu](http://www.frontrange.edu) > click Apply Now to create your FRCC account.
- Click “yes” to sign up for the College Opportunity Fund (COF) stipend.
- When finished, log back in to your account for your FRCC student id number (S# \_\_\_\_\_).

### 2 Sign up for the College Opportunity Fund (COF) stipend

- If you did not sign up as part of the admission application, you may sign up at <https://cof.college-assist.org>
- NOTE: This is a stipend that the State pays per credit in addition to what your high school pays. If you do not sign up for COF or have an error, you will be responsible for the bill.

### 3 Complete paperwork

- Return all required paperwork to your high school counselor.

### 4 Assessment test

- Check with your high school counselor or FRCC College Now staff to see whether you need to take the placement test for the class(es) you hope to take.

### 5 Register

- Sign up for classes in Front Range Community College’s eWOLF system. You must be registered before FRCC classes begin.
- Authorize the College Opportunity Fund stipend.
