<p>HESI Admission Assessment Exam cumulative score for the following subjects: Reading Comprehension, Chemistry, Biology, Math</p> <p><b>Minimum cumulative score 75%</b> <b>Score x 0.75 = Maximum 75 points</b></p> <p>HESI may only be taken once in 365 days and test scores can be used for up to 13 months.</p>	<b>75</b>	
<p>Additional points for HESI Biology exam</p> <p>86% or above = 5 points 80-85% = 2.5 points</p>	<b>5</b>	
<p>Additional points for HESI Chemistry exam</p> <p>86% or above = 3 points 80-85% = 1 points</p>	<b>3</b>	
<p>GPA calculated from following courses: ENG 121, PSY 235, BIO 201, and BIO 204. <b>Minimum GPA 2.75</b></p> <p><b>(GPA - 2.75) x 9.6 = Maximum 12 points</b></p> <p>Note: If prerequisite coursework is repeated, no more than one 'D' or 'F' in each of these courses is allowed.
