<p>HESI A2 Entrance Exam: Reading Comprehension, Chemistry, Biology, Math</p> <p>A minimum cumulative score of 80% is required to apply to the registered nursing program. The HESI A-2 may only be taken once in 365 days; test scores can be used for up to 15 months. The test is offered at the FRCC/Larimer Campus Testing Center and Prometric Testing Centers.</p> <p>Formula to calculate points: $\text{Score} \times 0.75 = \text{Maximum 75 points}$</p>	75	
<p>Points for HESI Biology</p> <p>86% or above= 5 points 80-85%= 2.5 points</p>	5	
<p>Points for HESI Chemistry</p> <p>86% or above = 3 points 80-85% = 1 point</p>	3	
<p>GPA calculated from following courses: ENG 121/ENG 122, PSY 235, BIO 201, and BIO 204</p> <p>A minimum GPA of 3.0 is required for coursework listed above. Formula to calculate GPA points: $(\text{GPA} - 3.0) \times 12 = \text{Maximum 12 points}$</p> <p>If the coursework above is repeated, no more than one 'D', or 'F' in each of the courses are allowed within the previous 5 years. All required science courses must be completed within 7 years of entry into the RN program. We will only look at the first two attempts of science courses within those 7 years and will take the higher grade. None of the coursework above may be in progress at the time of applying.</p>	12	
<p>Completion of BIO 202 with a grade of 'C' or higher prior to applying to the program</p>	2
