If the course grade falls below the required level at the time of admission, the spot will be vacated. Formula to calculate points: A = 20 pts, B= 10 pts, C = 5 pt Maximum points = 40 If prerequisites are not started or in process at the time of application, the grade will not be calculated. 	40
